A first responder who is sensitive and understands the nature of autism is better prepared to assist and make positive changes for people with autism and their families.

How can a state strengthen relationships between first responders and autistic people?

# **Training for First Responders**

Teaches first responders about autism and other developmental disabilities from a law enforcement and family perspective.

Focuses on de-escalation strategies through lectures, interactive learning, and video-based scenarios.
